outside in the Spring or start them growing inside. Cress is always good for a quick look at how seeds grow into plants.


You could try making a weather station with your child to record the weather and learn about different climates.



Life Cycles

Geography/History

During our Topic this term we will be looking at our local environment in detail. We will identify different features of our environment and keep a record of the weather. We will also look at the lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.



Maths
