We Are Learning About...

Maths:

During the Summer Term, we will be looking at being able to Multiply and Divide by making equal groups. In addition to this, we will begin looking at fractions of a quantity, such as a half and a quarter. Towards the end of our time in Year One, we will also begin looking at being able to count money, understand the value of different coins and read time to the nearest hour and half hour.



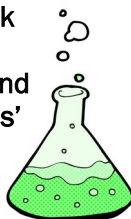
English:

This term in English, we are going to be looking at a number of different texts themed around Robots and The Great Outdoors. Children will also be exposed to a wide range of different text types and genres such as recounts, poems, information texts and stories from a range of familiar/ fantasy settings.



Science:

As we continue to progress through the year, children will continue to develop their understanding of Science and how to work scientifically through conducting investigations. Children will then also spend time learning all about 'Everyday Materials' and their properties.



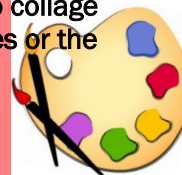
Geography/History:

For our last term in Year One, we will be learning all about The Circus and The Seaside. Children will look at how Blackpool's location made it the perfect holiday destination for people in the past. Children will also look at how Blackpool and its attractions have developed into the world famous resort that it is today.



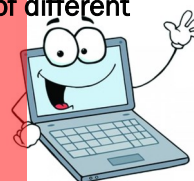
Art/Design Technology:

Within our Art and DT lessons, children will be looking at being able to design, plan and construct 3D models using a range of different resources and tools. Children also spend time looking at being able to collage pictures based upon stories, rhymes or the world around them.



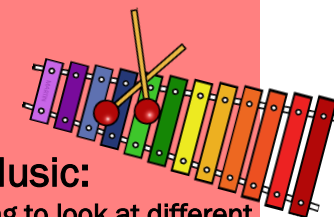
Computing:

In computing, we are looking at being able to create talking books. Later in the term we will also be looking at how to make and send digital greeting cards for a range of different occasions.



RSE/ PSHE:

During our RSE/ PSHE lessons, children will be looking at how to feel confident in themselves and how to talk about their feelings and emotions. Children will spend time looking at people who are special to them and why it is good for us all to be unique.



Music:

In Music we are going to look at different music that uses the theme 'your imagination'. The children will learn to play their own rhythms on glockenspiels and reflect on their musical learning from throughout the year. Children will also continue looking at different music notation.



PE:

During Summer term in PE, we will looking at the rules of popular sporting games such as tennis and the skills required to play these games effectively. All children will also participate in our whole school Sports Day that is held during the Summer term.



RE:

Religious Education is an incredibly important part of our Creative Curriculum here at Kin Craig. Therefore, this term the children will continue to learn all about Christianity and how some people show their belief in God. The children will then compare their knowledge of Christianity to the beliefs of Hinduism
