
THINGS TO DO:

YEAR 4 SUMMER TERM



WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT...

Maths:

Throughout the Summer term, children will be learning about decimals and look at how they are able to compare, order and round decimal numbers. In addition to this, the children will also develop their knowledge and understanding of money and time.

Finally, the children will end their time in Year Four looking at shape, space and measure with a focus on angles within shapes and being able to order and compare different angles.

English:

In English this term, children will be looking at a range of different text types. These will include studying poems of varying structures and themes. Children will also analyse and write their own information booklets about a given theme. Finally, the children will study stories about a given theme and they will also look at folk tales and their unique structure too.

Science:

Year Four will look at the Electricity and the different States of Matter. Children will begin looking at the different components used within simple circuits and will be able to build and scientifically draw their own examples. Children will also then be able to comment upon whether objects are a solid, liquid or gas. Children will finally look at the process of evaporation and condensation within the Water Cycle.

Geography/History:

Our topic on 'Lancashire Life' will see us learn about the Industrial Revolution and the changes in Lancashire during this time. We will also find out about Queen Victoria and what life was like for children living within this period of history. Throughout the summer term, we will also spend time looking at significant events that took place during Queen Victoria's reign.

Art/Design Technology:

Our Art and DT topics will see the children using weaving, montage and gears and cams. Children will continue to develop their understanding of how colour selection and the effect creative choices can have on the final outcome and aesthetics of a piece of art.



Computing:

In computing, we will learn to create a toy that uses a computer programming to make it work. We will also find out how green screen technology works. We will then use this new found knowledge to record our own weather forecasts.

PSHE:

In PSHE, we will be learning about how important it is to stay healthy and who can help us with this. We will also look at the environment and how we can protect and look after it so that we are all able to enjoy it.

Music:

In music we will be looking at the song 'Blackbird'. We will continue to improve our musical knowledge and understanding of key vocabulary such as tempo, pitch and rhythm. We will then also use our knowledge of different musical notation to compose our own music around a given theme.

PE:

In PE we are focusing on athletics and games. We will look at striking games such as tennis and rounders and also improve our physical skills within running, jumping and throwing events. We will also begin to prepare for our school Sports Day.

RE:

We are learning about Islam and focusing on Ramadan and why Muslims fast during this time.

We will also look at some parables and learn about Jesus' teachings of 'Love Thy Neighbour' and what this means to Christians.
