Nursery Fees for 2 Year Olds
Full day - £52.00 Full School day - £42.00 Half School day - £23.00 Breakfast Club - £6.00 Afterschool Club - £12.00 Lunchtime (care and meal) - £5.00 paid if child completing full day on grant sessions or would like to add meals.
Kincraig Nursery is open <u>Term-Time</u> only and therefore you will not be charged during school holidays. Fees will not be charged for Bank Holidays.
All Nursery fees must be paid in advance each week. Payments can be made through the school office or through the ScoPay App.
Arrears will not be tolerated and if payments are not kept up to date, your child's place will be reviewed and potentially withdrawn.
If your child is absent from Nursery or sent home due to illness, you will still be expected to pay for your child's place for that day. If you are looking at changing your nursery sessions or wish to cancel your nursery place a minimum of 2 weeks notice is required. However it is important to note all grant funding is paid termly and cannot be transferred to another setting until the 1 st January, April or September.
