Museum is closer and has lots to see, including some Ancient Greek artefacts. You would also get to see the famous Poulton Elk.

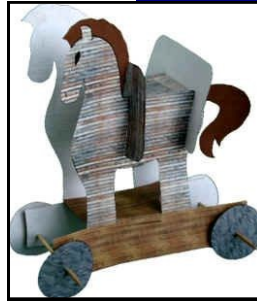

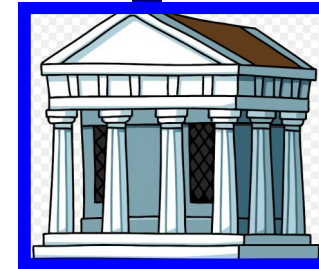
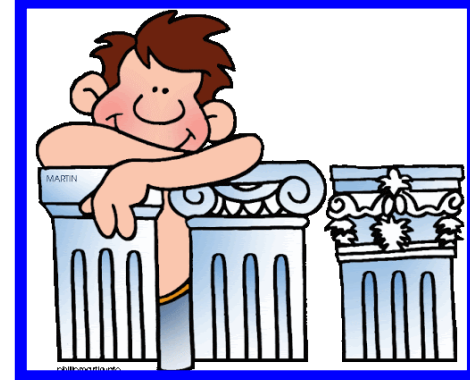

Ancient Greece



Geography/History

During our Topic this term we will be looking at Ancient Greece. We will find out about the beliefs in this important time in and its effect on history. We will also use maps to identify mountains and seas in this area of Europe.

Art/Design Technology

In art this term we will look at drawing people who are moving and techniques to help us. We are also going to make our own pop-up books. In DT, we are going to make salt dough and use this to make Ancient Greek style jewellery.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be thinking about Keeping Safe and Money. The units will focus on different situations where we might need to keep safe and how to look after our money when spending and borrowing.

Maths

In Maths we will be improving our mathematical knowledge by focusing on Decimals, Properties of Shape, Position and Direction and Measurements. We will continue to build on our previous learning and improve our skills in preparation for Year 6.

English

In English this term we are going to look at Myths and stories from other cultures. The children will also look at writing debates and reports. To conclude the term, the children will then also look at poems with figurative language in them.

French

During our weekly French lessons, we will be looking at being able to discuss where we live and we will also be looking at French food and breakfast time vocabulary.

Science

The Science topic this term is Animals including Humans. During this topic we will focus on the development of humans from birth to old age,

Music

In music we will look at the song 'Dancing In The Street'. We will also reflect on the learning we have done over the year and recap some key elements.

Computing

During our weekly Computing lessons we will be looking at how we are able to use vector graphics. We will also look at creating quizzes where children have to use selection.

PE

Our topics during this term is athletics and striking and field games. We will look at different athletics events and focus on cricket in games.

RE

In RE we will focus on Buddhism and Christianity. In Buddhism we will learn about 'Contentment' in the religion and in Christianity we will learn about the holy trinity.
